I hope when this bulletin comes out, you would put

it in wide circulation and send the same to State Governments and State Dairy Federations with your recommendation to them to initiate such programs in the interest of health and nutrition of children of schools and Aanganwadis.

In the article, contribution of SMP is mentioned. When the dairy industry is stuck with SMP stocks (as during last year in India), such stocks can be melted by the noble program of milk for school (and Aanganwadi) children. A largely win win situation with the generosity of state governments.
