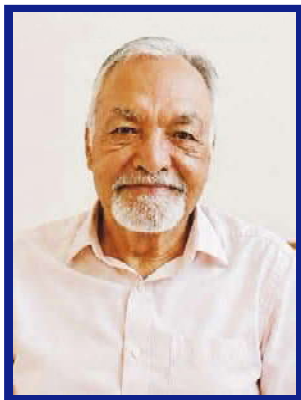


Obituary

Shri Subhash Chander Malik



1950-2026

The dairy fraternity lost one of its most respected pioneers with the passing of Late Shri Subhash Chander Malik. A visionary entrepreneur, distinguished engineer and compassionate human being, Shri Malik leaves behind a legacy built on integrity, innovation, perseverance and service.

Born on 21st September 1950 into a humble family, Shri Malik believed that success is achieved through hard work, honesty and an unwavering commitment to excellence. He belonged to the first batch of graduates and postgraduates of the National Dairy Research Institute (NDRI), Karnal. The technical knowledge and professional values acquired during his years at

NDRI laid the foundation for his remarkable contribution to India's dairy engineering sector.

Shri Malik founded Nutech Dairy Engineering Ltd., transforming it from a modest enterprise into one of India's leading manufacturers of dairy processing plants. Under his visionary leadership, the company earned a reputation for engineering excellence, innovation, quality and ethical business practices, making a significant contribution to the modernization of the Indian dairy industry. Today, the company continues to grow under the leadership of his elder son, Shri Gagan Malik, carrying forward his vision and values.

Despite his professional achievements, Shri Malik remained humble and deeply connected to his friends, especially his NDRI classmates, with whom he maintained lifelong relationships spanning more than five decades. His warmth, loyalty and commitment to friendship reflected the values that defined his personality.

A natural mentor, Shri Malik believed that true success lies in empowering others. He guided numerous engineers, technicians and entrepreneurs, many of whom established successful manufacturing enterprises of their own.
